Downloadable Audiobooks and Downloadable e-books

To Access: Click the Download audiobooks link on the Minuteman home page or enter: <http://digital.minlib.net>

Hardware & software needed:

Windows

- Windows 98 SE or newer
- Windows Media Player 9 or newer
- OverDrive Media Console for Windows
- For transfer to Apple devices—Windows XP or newer and iTunes v7.6.2.9 or newer

Mac

- Mac Computer with Intel Power PC processor
- Mac OS10.4.9 or newer
- OverDrive Media Console for Mac
- iTunes version v7.6.2.9 or newer

How do I install OverDrive media Console?

- The first time you access audiobooks, you will have to download OverDrive media console
- Scroll to the bottom of the OverDrive page and click on OverDrive Media Console
- Click on the download link

- When the download is complete, click the Open button and follow the steps in the Wizard
- A Windows security upgrade is required to open a DRM protected file
- Open the Tools menu in Overdrive media console and select Windows Media Player Security Upgrade

What portable devices are supported?

- MP3 players, Smartphones, Apple devices, and the Sony Reader for eBooks

How much free space will I need on my portable device?

Audiobooks are delivered in parts. Each part is about 36MB. In OverDrive Media Console v. 3.2, the Transfer Wizard will alert you if you do not have enough space on your device to transfer all of the selected files.

How do I check out a downloadable Audiobook?

After finding an available title, click the Add to Cart button. The title will remain in your cart for 30 minutes, and you can place up to 5 titles in your cart at the same time. Click Proceed to Checkout to complete the check out process. You must enter you library card number and pin and then click Sign In. Click the Confirm Check Out button

How do I download the Audiobook?

Click on the Download button to open the OverDrive Media Console. In the Get Media dialog box, select a download location and then click OK. At the next screen, select the parts to be downloaded. After the download is complete, you will be able to close your Internet connection and listen to the book on your computer or transfer the book to a portable device.

How long can I check out a downloadable Audiobook and can it be renewed?

For most titles the check out period is 7 or 14 days. Items cannot be renewed but can be checked out again if they are available. A user may check out up to 3 items at a time.

Can I place a hold on an Audiobook?

How do I transfer the title to a portable device?

- Connect your device to the USB port on your computer.
- In OverDrive Media Console, highlight the title you want to transfer and click the Transfer button.

The Transfer Wizard will search for a connected portable device. Click Next to begin the transfer. A success message will display when the transfer is complete.

What is Wish List?

- Wish List can be used to keep track of items you have checked out or may be interested in checking out.
- Click add to wish list to place the title on your wish list.
- If a title on Wish List is available for check out, click the Add to cart button and then Proceed to Checkout to check out the title.
- Titles with a future release date may be

added to Wish List but not to My Cart.

- Items remain on Wish List after they are checked out
- To remove a title from Wish List, sign in to your account and click the Wish List link. Click the Remove link to remove the title from the list.



Audiobook Formats

- WMA Audiobooks are Windows compatible and use Digital Rights Management protection from Microsoft. They are not supported by the Mac operating system.
- Many WMA Audiobooks can be transferred to Apple devices using the Transfer Wizard in OverDrive media console.
- MP3 Audiobooks are Windows and Mac compatible and can be transferred to mobile devices including iPods.
